When the overworked manager Shirley tries to keep order among ex-truckers, retired partiers, and one unhinged park ranger with a pet llama, chaos is guaranteed. Between fireworks gone wrong, a viral parade, and a dump-tank disaster, this offbeat comedy serves up Native humor, small-town antics, and genuine heart. It's Parks & Recreation meets Trailer Park Boys, with a little Golden Girls grit and Letterkenny pace — filmed with an authentic Southern-Native mix that captures America's forgotten funny bone.
